The Diversity & Inclusion Fellowship is designed to provide an opportunity for law students, with the goal of providing career mentoring and helping students explore their interest and succeed in practicing intellectual property law.

HARNESS IP DIVERSITY & INCLUSION FELLOWSHIP

The Diversity & Inclusion Fellowship includes:

- Paid summer clerkship with Harness IP in one or more of its four Metro offices (Dallas, TX; Detroit, MI; St. Louis, MO;
 Washington, DC) during the summer of 2023, compensated at Harness IP's standard summer associate rate.
- \$5,000 in law school tuition assistance upon successful completion of candidate's summer clerkship with the firm.
- · Mentor that is assigned for the summer clerkship will also be available to assist the student during the following school year.
- The Fellowship may be renewed after completion of another summer clerkship with Harness IP based on mutual agreement.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Diversity & Inclusion Fellowship, candidates must:

- Be a member of one of the underrepresented racial/ethnic groups defined by the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission,
 a member of the LGBTQ community, an individual with a disability, a woman, or a veteran.
- Be in good standing as a law student at an ABA-accredited law school.
- Have a degree in engineering, life sciences/chemistry, computer science, or substantial prior trademark, copyright, or related
 job experience.
- · Have excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Demonstrate leadership qualities and community involvement.
- · Contribute to diversity efforts through involvement in law school or other community efforts.
- Be a U.S. citizen or authorized to work in the U.S.
- · Complete a successful summer clerkship with the firm.
- Have a strong interest in joining Harness IP as an associate after law school graduation.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered as a candidate for the Diversity & Inclusion Fellowship, candidates must provide the following documents:

- Completed Diversity & Inclusion Fellowship Application Form before February 15, 2023.
- Current resume.
- · Undergraduate and law school transcripts.
- · Personal statement (500 words or more) addressing how the candidate will contribute to the legal profession diversity goals.
- Two professional or academic references.
- · Legal writing sample.
- Any other pertinent information a candidate believes may be helpful for the firm to know.

SELECTION PROCESS

A selection panel consisting of the Chairs of various firm committees, including but not limited to the Diversity & Inclusion Committee, will evaluate all applications and select Program recipients.

APPLICATION DATES

Applications will be accepted through February 15, 2023.
